### ALL THE DRAMA

If you're a fan of colour, this 100% wool carpet is for you. Its the base of the jewel-toned scheme with a cut-pile finish giving it an almost velvet-like texture making it super soft underfoot, too. Richelieu Velour 1002 carpet from the Wilton Collection, from £69.99 per sq m. Louis de Poortere.



### RELAXING NEUTRALS

Ideal for a calm, unfussy scheme that invites you to kick back and wind down, natural tones such as beige or light shades of brown and grey create warmth without overwhelming the room. Galloway Luce carpet in Osprey, £56 per sq m, Brockway.



### CLASSIC STRIPES

Whether in fashion or home interiors, stripes never go out of style. This particular design also includes subtle chevrons, so looks great close up as well as at a distance. It's an 80% wool and 20% nylon Woven Axminster carpet. Quirky B Hot Herring carpet in Teal, £103.35 per sq m, Alternative Flooring.

"A good underlay helps prevent the carpet pile from flattening, meaning it will retain its appearance for longer. It's also excellent for sound insulation and retaining heat. Some underlays are recycled from the thread and yarn waste from carpet factories so it goes full circle."
